I/We confirm that our business authorizes us to carry on the trade or employment role to be conducted by this visitor, subsequent to the grant of a Visitors Work Visa. It is fully understood by this company that the Visitors Work Visa is not a Business Visitors Permit as provided for at Section 54 of the Immigration Law and as such does not contain any of its privileges. Similarly, it is fully understood by this company that the Visitors Work Visa is not connected to a Temporary Work Permit as provided for at Section 53 of the Immigration Law and also does not count for time spent as Legal and Ordinary resident on the island. In addition it is also understood that if our operating license is not valid that the visitor will not be granted a Visitors Work Visa and will not be allowed to work.

The visitor on arrival must make payment for each visit in Cayman Islands dollars or the US dollar equivalent, payable by debit card or major credit card only (all major credit cards accepted except American Express).

We acknowledge that the provision of false or misleading information to the Department of Immigration constitutes an offence and that the Department of Immigration retains full authority to deny entry notwithstanding the fact of invitation or if landing requirements are not met by the visitor. We also understand that the Department of Immigration may require that such correspondence be notarized prior to dissemination.

I further attest that, to the best of my knowledge and belief, the above details are true and correct. I declare that the information provided above by me is true and correct and I understand and accept that if it is proven that I have made a false statement, I am liable on conviction to a fine of C.I. \$5000 and imprisonment for one year.
