

Guidance for Medical Examinations form

Use this form:

In addition to the applicable application form, this form should be completed when you wish to apply for a Work Permit, certain residency applications and certain Right to be Caymanian applications.

Submission requirements:

Medical examinations are required on initial application for work permit and once in every three years thereafter. The Immigration Department reserves the right to require medical examinations at any time.

Laboratory tests have to be repeated with each medical examination. Results must bear the Medical Practitioner's or the laboratory's stamp or seal as well as an original signature.

Chest X-rays are required once in every five years. For renewal applications, a chest x-ray is not required if the previous x-rays were done within four years of application.

Laboratory reports have to be attached for HIV and VDRL tests, unless one was submitted within the last six months of submission.

Medical practitioners are advised to perform any tests that might be desirable depending on the disease prevalence in the respective countries.

What happens next?

A letter will be sent to you, notifying you of the decision of the appropriate Board/Chief Immigration Officer.

Under the Law an applicant is required to provide a complete application which has been defined as above. Failure to comply with the above could result in a refusal by the relevant Board/Chief Immigration Officer.
