TO APPLY FOR A NEW VISA, THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE REQUIRED:

- a) A printed confirmation page of the completed electronic application form DS-160. This form, along with detailed instructions for use, is available at the following Website: <https://ceac.state.gov/genniv/>. **This form must be completed and submitted online;**
- b) Valid Cayman Islands Passport that will not expire within the next six months. There should be sufficient blank pages available in the passport to affix a visa, should a visa be granted; each applicant must possess their own passport (**no visas will be issued to children who are added to parent's passport**)
- c) Expired or other Passport (if held a U.S. visa before);
- d) 1 full face photograph (white or off-white background);
- e) **USD\$160.00** – Please check website for details.
- f) A recent Police Clearance for **ANY** applicant sixteen years of age or older;
- g) Any additional documents that may demonstrate the applicant's social and economic ties outside the United States, or that otherwise help to support or clarify the application.
 - Original birth Certificate
 - Copy of parent's valid passport data page and valid US Visa (if the applicant is a child)

PERSONAL INTERVIEW

A personal interview at the **United States Embassy in Kingston, Jamaica** will be required, but is **not limited to**, the following applicants:

- If you are 14 to 79 years of age and applying for a US Visitor's visa for the **FIRST TIME or RENEWAL**
- Applicants 80 years old and older applying for a US Visitor's Visa for the first time
- You **MUST** schedule an appointment time for your interview. Appointments can be made by sending an e-mail to: KingstonTransApp@state.gov. Prior to sending the e-mail please check the website for the details which need to be provided.
- Applicants who have made an appointment but has a genuine emergency should now send a request via email to: kingstonniveemergency@state.gov or contact 1 876 702 6000.
