THE IMMIGRATION (AMENDMENT) (NO. 3) REGULATIONS, 2017

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 40(1)(b) and 99(1) of the Immigration Law (2015 Revision), the Cabinet makes the following Regulations -

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations, 2017. Citation

2. The Immigration Regulations (2015 Revision) are amended in regulation 11, by inserting after subregulation (2), the following subregulations - Amendment of regulation 11 of the Immigration Regulations (2015 Revision) - exemptions from requirement for work permit
 - “(3) Notwithstanding subregulations (1) and (2), a person arriving in the Islands is not required to obtain a work permit if -
 - (a) the purpose is to engage in temporary employment as a professional in any role or activity listed in subregulation (4) in relation to music recording;
 - (b) the person’s employment is limited to the professional role or activity for which the work permit exemption was granted in accordance with this subregulation;
 - (c) the temporary employment period does not exceed six months in a twelve month period;
 - (d) the person ceases to be employed in the Islands after the person completes the work in respect of which the work permit exemption was granted in accordance with this subregulation; and
 - (e) no other activity is carried out within that six-month period that would otherwise require a work permit.
 - (4) The roles and activities referred to in subregulation (3) are -
 - (a) musician;
 - (b) personal attendant;
 - (c) personal advisor;
 - (d) manager;

- (e) producer;
- (f) technologist;
- (g) personal pilot and crew;
- (h) vocal and musical coach;
- (i) record label staff;
- (j) album coordinator;
- (k) project manager;
- (l) publicist;
- (m) technical support;
- (n) session musician;
- (o) band member;
- (p) back-up singer;
- (q) personal photographer;
- (r) management and administrative staff;
- (s) promoter;
- (t) marketing and promotions staff;
- (u) choreographer;
- (v) writer;
- (w) lyricist; and
- (x) creative support staff.”.
