 (3) by mutual consent or agreement or any other reason whether voluntary or not;  
 (4) in circumstances where, in the opinion of the Board, the marriage has irretrievably broken down.

5. That I have not lived apart from my spouse immediately preceding this application and that I do not intend to live apart from my spouse in the foreseeable future and; if I do become separated from my spouse, I will immediately notify the Director of WORC that my spouse and I no longer live together.

**Warning:** It is an offence under the Immigration Law (2018 Revision) for any person to make, cause or allow to be made any return, statement or representation which is false in a material particular and which he knows to be false or which he does not believe to be true. A person found guilty of this offence is liable on summary conviction in respect of a first offence, to a fine of \$5,000.00 and to imprisonment for one year or, in respect of a second or subsequent offence, to a fine of ten thousand dollars and to imprisonment for two years.

By making an application for the re-issue of a Residency & Employment Rights Certificate, you agree to cooperate with the Director of Work Opportunities Residency Cayman (WORC) /Caymanian Status and Permanent Residency Board or its duly appointed agents by providing such information or documents as they may reasonably request in connection with your application.

If the Director of Work Opportunities Residency Cayman (WORC)/Caymanian Status and Permanent Residency Board has reasonable grounds to believe that any fact stated in any application for a Residency and Employment Rights Certificate (including any affidavit sworn in such application) is false in a material particular, the Board or it's duly appointed agents may conduct a full investigation in such manner as it deems fit.
