

Guidance for US Visa Waiver application form

Use this form:

When you wish to travel for a one-time visit to the United States using a Cayman Islands (British Overseas Territories Citizen) passport, traveling directly from the Cayman Islands to the US

Submission requirements:

In submitting this form you should enclose the following (where appropriate):

- Your valid Cayman Islands Passport. CI passports must be valid for at least six months beyond the date of intended departure from the US. CI passports must be machine readable for a US visa waiver to be issued
- CI\$25.00 cash/cheque for a three-to-four business days service or CI\$50.00 for an Express Service
- A recent Police Clearance Certificate for applicants 13 years of age or older. A police clearance certificate is valid for three months but may only be used for one entry into the US. If your police certificate lists any convictions, a US Visa waiver cannot be issued.

Please note: you should submit your completed application at least four business days prior to your departure date. If you require a waiver prior to this, you may be required to submit supporting documents to verify your travel plans.

Please note District Administration in Cayman Brac handles applications for US visa waivers for residents in Cayman Brac and Little Cayman.

What happens next?

Once your travel documents have been filed with the Passport & Corporate Services Office and a date/time arranged for collection, you must ensure that they are collected prior to your departure.
